









1. Modern professional and traditional professional occupations such as: teacher, nurse, physiotherapist, social worker, musician, police officer (sergeant or above), software designer, accountant, solicitor, medical practitioner, scientist, civil / mechanical engineer	19.91%
2. Senior, middle or junior managers or administrators such as: finance manager, chief executive, large business owner, office manager, retail manager, bank manager, restaurant manager, warehouse manager	15.64%
3. Clerical and intermediate occupations such as: secretary, personal assistant, call centre agent, clerical worker, nursery nurse	7.11%
